Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are prohibited.

No smoking in buildings.

Please dispose of trash properly.

No fireworks.

**No one is permitted on climbing wall or ropes courses without D.M. Instructors.**

**Pool:** NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY – swim at your own risk. Pool hours determined by D.M. staff.  
Children under 12 must be supervised by an adult (over 17).  
Please shower before entering pool.  
Please wear non-white t-shirts over two-piece suits.  
Don't hang on rope, run or rough-house in the pool area.  
No glass, food or drink is allowed into the pool area.

**Fires:** Build fires in metal fire rings and 20 feet from trees, tents or RVs.  
Use only dead wood. Never cut or harm live trees.  
Fires are prohibited during drought or windy conditions.  
Do not leave fires unattended.

**Pets:** Pets are not allowed in the buildings.  
Pets must be leashed and supervised at all times.  
You will need to remove your pet if it is a nuisance to campers or staff.  
Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after pet and any damage the pet does.
